

Appleby family's Cheshire cheese is just champion

SHROPSHIRE'S Appleby family are Cheshire champions.

They won the Cheshire Agricultural Society's Champion Cheshire Cheese trophy at the county's annual show at Tabley.

The cheese made by the Appleby's is the original Cheshire cheese, still made by hand in the traditional way using unpasteurised milk from the Appleby's own cows.

Once made, the cheese is bound in calico and stored in maturing rooms before being distributed around the UK and exported to countries such as America.

The winning cheese was three months old, having been made on March 27 at Hawkstone Abbey Farm.
